**LAST DAY TO FILE CANDIDATE DECLARATION OF INTENTION
AND FIRST DAY TO FILE NOMINATING PETITIONS**

LOS ANGELES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (LAUSD), BOARD DISTRICT 1 SPECIAL ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (February 13, 2014) – Los Angeles Interim City Clerk Holly Wolcott reminds all candidates running for office that the last day to file a Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate for the 2014 LAUSD, Board District 1 Special Election is **Tuesday, February 18, 2014 at 5:00 p.m.**

In order to appear on the June 3, 2014 Special Election ballot, candidates for LAUSD, Board District 1 Office must file a Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate and submit a qualifying nominating petition.

Candidates who have filed their Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate may obtain their nominating petitions **beginning Monday, February 10, 2014**. The period to file completed nominating petitions **begins Tuesday, February 18, 2014** and ends on **Friday, March 7, 2014 at 5:00 p.m.**

All candidates must file their Declaration of Intention and nominating petitions at the Office of the City Clerk - Election Division during the periods as noted below:

Nomination Petition Filing Period:

February 18 - March 7, 2014 *
