LAST DAY TO FILE NOMINATING AND SUPPLEMENTAL PETITIONS
LOS ANGELES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (LAUSD), BOARD DISTRICT 1 SPECIAL ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (March 4, 2014) – Los Angeles Interim City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott reminds all potential candidates for the LAUSD, Board District 1 Special Election that the last day to file their nominating petitions, and supplemental petitions if required, is **Friday, March 7, 2014 at 5:00 p.m.**

In order to appear on the June 3, 2014 LAUSD, Board District 1 Special Election ballot, candidates for LAUSD, Board District 1 must file a Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate and submit a qualifying nominating petition. When filing a nominating petition, each candidate must choose to either: a) pay a filing fee of \$300 and submit valid signatures of at least 500 but no more than 1,000 qualified, registered voters within LAUSD, Board District 1 or b) waive the filing fee and submit valid signatures of at least 1,000 but not more than 2,000 qualified, registered voters within LAUSD, Board District 1.

Candidates who submitted nominating petitions early, but did not meet the required number of qualified voters' signatures, may file a supplemental petition. However, please note that all supplemental petitions must be filed by the same final deadline as nominating petitions, which is Friday, March 7, 2014 at 5:00 p.m.

To summarize, all candidates must file their nominating petitions at the Election Division during the periods as noted below:
