LAST DAY TO APPLY FOR A VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT

LOS ANGELES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (LAUSD), BOARD DISTRICT 1 SPECIAL RUNOFF ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (August 1, 2014) — Interim City Clerk Holly Wolcott announced today that applications for a Vote-By-Mail (VBM) ballot for the August 12, 2014 LAUSD, Board District 1 Special Runoff Election must be received by the Office of the City Clerk - Election Division by Tuesday, August 5, 2014 at 5:00 p.m.

As an alternative to submitting an application, you may also request a mail ballot by submitting a letter with the name and date of the election and your registered address and signature.

Voted VBM ballots may be dropped off at any LAUSD, Board District 1 polling place or received in the Election Division Office **by the close of polls (8:00 p.m.) on Election Day, August 12, 2014**. A postmarked date is not considered valid.
