**LOS ANGELES** (August 5, 2014) — Interim City Clerk Holly Wolcott reminds voters that the August 12, 2014 LAUSD, Board District 1 Special Runoff Election **is just 7 days away**. All registered voters in LAUSD, Board District 1 are encouraged to review their Official Sample Ballot (OSB) before going to vote.

## **Voting on Election Day**

The location of your polling place can be found on the back cover of your OSB or on the Election Division website. If your voting location has changed, a letter has been mailed to you with the updated information. Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. Moreover, if you have a Vote-By-Mail ballot but don't have time to mail it back in time, you can drop it off at any LAUSD, Board District 1 polling place by 8:00 p.m. or in the Election Division Office's Piper Technical Center by the close of polls (8:00 p.m.) on Election Day, August 12, 2014. A postmarked date is not considered valid.
