SCHEDULE OF PUBLIC OBSERVATION EVENTS

LOS ANGELES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (LAUSD), BOARD DISTRICT 1 SPECIAL RUNOFF ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (August 7, 2014) — Interim City Clerk Holly Wolcott announced today that media, candidates, and the public are welcome to attend several events related to the August 12, 2014 LAUSD, Board District 1 Special Runoff Election.

Vote-By-Mail (VBM) Inspection and Tally

Inspection of VBM ballots (i.e., preparation for the tally) will begin Saturday, August 9, 2014 at 8:30 a.m. to approximately 6:00 p.m. and will continue until 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Tuesday, August 12, 2014. The tally of VBM ballots will begin the afternoon of August 12, 2014, Election Day. The results of this tally will not be released until after the close of polls at 8:00 p.m.

August 12th Election Day Events

Polling places open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m. The first unofficial bulletin will be released at approximately 8:30 p.m. that night, consisting exclusively of VBM ballots previously received and processed. At-polls ballots will begin to arrive at Piper Technical Center at approximately 9:00 p.m. At-polls ballot inspection begins when ballots arrive and continues until the last at-polls ballots arrive, between approximately 11:00 p.m. and 12:00 a.m. (midnight). Ballots will be tallied as they complete the inspection process and updated bulletins will be released periodically throughout the night.

Election Night Tours

On Election Night, a limited number of tours will be conducted by the Office of the City Clerk - Election Division that will "follow the ballots" from a polling place to the Election Operations Center (EOC) located at Piper Technical Center. The tours will take place from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and will both begin and end at the EOC. Tours must have a minimum of six people and each person must RSVP. Election Night Results Bulletin

We invite you to join us on Election Night as bulletins containing results for the LAUSD, Board District 1 Special Runoff Election will be released to the media, candidates, and the public on the 3rd floor of Piper Technical Center, Space 375. Unofficial results will be released starting at approximately 8:30 p.m. and updates will continue in approximately 15 to 20 minute intervals

Official Canvass

The Official Canvass of the August 12, 2014 LAUSD, Board District 1 Special Runoff Election, legally mandated by the City Charter, begins on August 13, 2014 and continues to completion. The canvass begins at approximately 11:00 a.m. and ends at 5:00 p.m. on the day following the election. From there on, the canvass will continue daily from 8:30 a.m. to approximately 6:00 p.m. until completion. The Official Canvass includes VBM Envelope and Provisional Envelope Verification, Ballot Inspection, Write-In Ballot Canvass, Roster Reconciliation, and the One Percent Manual Tally, and must be completed on or before September 2, 2014.
