
POLLING PLACE INFORMATION

2015 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (February 26, 2015) — City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott reminds voters that the location of their polling place for the March 3, 2015 Primary Nominating Election can be found in several different areas.

To find your polling place the following options are available:

- Log on to the City Clerk's election website: <u>http://clerk.lacity.org/Elections/</u>. Click on "Polling Place and Official Sample Ballot Look up."
- Call the City Clerk Election Division at (213) 978-0444 or toll-free at (888) 873-1000.
- Call the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk at (562) 466-1310.
- Check the back cover of your Official Sample Ballot (OSB). Below are examples of the OSB.
