LOS ANGELES (March 3, 2015) — City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott reminds voters to go vote today, Tuesday, March 3, 2015 in the Primary Nominating Election. The Office of the City Clerk administers elections for the City of Los Angeles, the Los Angeles Unified School District, and the Los Angeles Community College District. Polls are open today from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. All registered voters are encouraged to review their Official Sample Ballot (OSB) before going to vote.

- Check the back cover of your OSB or the change-of-polling-place letter that was mailed to you.
