**INFORMATIONAL STATUS REPORT:  
2015 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION**

**LOS ANGELES** (March 12, 2015) — City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced the release of an unofficial Informational Status Report (attached for your reference) which includes outstanding Vote-By-Mail (VBM) and polling place ballots from the March 3, 2015 Primary Nominating Election, that were not counted on Election Night. This unofficial status report, which is also available on our website at <http://clerk.lacity.org/Elections/>, adds those additional VBM and polling place ballots to the totals in the Unofficial Election Night Results Bulletin and is intended to provide an informational update while we continue to verify and inspect other outstanding ballots.

Upon completion of our canvass period, we will release an Official Final Bulletin which will reflect the total of all ballots cast for the 2015 Primary Nominating Election.
