PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to authority for the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) to enter into a proposed agreement with 3Di, Incorporated to build the Fire Inspection Management System (FIMS), a customized software system utilized to better manage brush inspection clearance.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Chief, LAFD, or designee, to execute the proposed agreement between the LAFD and 3Di, Incorporated for the development and implementation of the FIMS for five years from the date of execution, with one five-year extension option, for a total maximum compensation amount of \$2,782,080, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that expenditures through this agreement are supported by a \$3.27 million appropriation (\$2.22 million in the Contractual Services Account and \$1.05 million in the Office and Administrative Account) to the LAFD by the Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety's Development Services Trust Fund (DSTF). Currently, the LAFD has expended \$1.76 million of the DSTF appropriation through another related agreement, leaving an unspent balance of \$1.51 million. The estimated cost of the proposed agreement (Agreement) is \$2.78 million, of which \$1.51 million is for project implementation and \$1.27 million, or \$317,820 annually, is for subsequent maintenance services. Continued service costs through a five-year extension option will cost up to an additional \$1.74 million, which will increase the total Agreement maximum compensation to \$4.52 million. Annual service costs are not DSTF-eligible expenses and will, therefore, result in a General Fund obligation of \$1.27 million for the first five years and an additional \$1.74 million for the five-year extension. Should eligible costs exceed the available DSTF appropriation, the LAFD will be required to request additional appropriations from the DSTF. The LAFD must identify any cost savings within budgeted funds to support the annual service costs included in this Agreement.



Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the action stated in this report is in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that one-time revenues will be used to fund one-time expenditures.

  - b. Submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit the grant receipts in the LAPD Grant Fund No. 339/70.
  - c. Prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments as necessary to implement Mayor and Council intentions, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO); and, authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.

3. AUTHORIZE the Controller to:
  - a. Establish a grant receivable and appropriate \$52,000 to appropriation account, account number to be determined, within Fund No. 339/70, for the receipt and disbursement of the FY 2021-22 RTAC Program grant funds.
  - b. Increase appropriations for the FY 2021-22 RTAC Program grant as needed from appropriation account, account number to be determined, in Fund No. 339/70 to Fund No. 100/70, account number and amount as follows:

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a Second Amendment between the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) and Purvis System, Inc. for the second phase of the Fire Station Alerting System replacement project.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Chief, LAFD, or designee, to execute the First Amendment with Purvis Systems, Inc., to incorporate language relative to compliance with the General Prevailing Wage Rates.
2. APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Chief, LAFD, or designee, to execute the proposed Second Amendment with Purvis Systems, Inc., for the second phase of the City's replacement of the Fire Station Alerting System. The term of the proposed amendment will extend the term by one year through June 30, 2022; and, increase the maximum allowable compensation by \$243,703 from \$3,710,690 to \$3,954,393, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that approval of the recommendations stated in this report will authorize the LAFD to extend the original two year agreement with Purvis Systems, Inc., for one additional year through June 30, 2022. The maximum allowable

compensation shall increase by \$243,703 from \$3,710,690 to \$3,954,393. Funding for the Fire Station Alerting System replacement project was funded in the 2018-19 Adopted Budget in the amount of \$4.0 million through the Municipal Improvement Corporation of Los Angeles financing program, and subsequent reappropriations. The CAO found that the proposed agreement is in accordance with the provisions of the Mayor's Belt Tightening memo dated March 19, 2020, whereas new contractual agreements will be authorized that are essential to public health and safety. There is no additional impact on the General Fund.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the recommendations stated in this report are in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that one-time funds will be used to fund one-time expenditures.

The City is a conduit issuer and does not incur liability for the repayment of the bonds, which are a limited obligation payable solely from the revenues of the Project, and the City will in no way be obligated to make payments on the bonds.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the recommendations in the subject CAO report, dated August 5, 2021, comply with the City's Financial Policies.

Debt Impact Statement: The CAO reports that there is no debt impact as these bonds are a conduit issuance debt and not a debt of the City.

## MOTION

California and the Los Angeles Region are currently suffering from a growing drought crisis. Low rainfall levels from prior rain seasons and continued demand for water is impacting state and regional water supplies. In an effort to address this, the Mayor and the City Council's *Los Angeles Green New Deal*, among other objectives, seeks to reduce dependence on imported water by increasing sustainable and environmentally-friendly practices.

If continued, this approach will help to establish and bolster local water supplies and meet future regional reliability and resiliency needs.

However, water conservation efforts and sustainability objectives can be difficult for small businesses to integrate into their operations. Small businesses usually do not have the financial resources nor the experience to implement viable water management and conservation practices.


This situation is made worse by the recent impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on local small businesses. Often times, small businesses must deal with increasing water costs while struggling to remain open. The economic hardships on small businesses are evident throughout the City including the San Fernando Valley.

This matter can be addressed if there is an effective way for small businesses to integrate water conservation and sustainability objectives into their day-to-day activities. To achieve this, the Department of Water and Power (DWP) and the Bureau of Sanitation and the Environment (LASAN) can play a significant role in educating small businesses about effective water use and conservation practices inasmuch as they maintain expertise in these areas.

The DWP and LASAN may develop programs specifically geared for small businesses so that they may be able to maximize water conservation efforts and minimize water costs; thereby allowing small businesses to meet economic challenges.



WHEREAS, any official position of the City of Los Angeles with respect to legislation, rules, regulations or policies proposed to or pending before a local, state or federal governmental body or agency must first have been adopted in the form of a Resolution by the City Council with the concurrence of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change maintains that we have until 2030 to transform our economy and the way we live to avoid the most catastrophic and irreversible effects of the climate crisis; and

WHEREAS, extreme weather events stemming from the climate crisis are already causing devastating floods and fires all over the world – including in Southern California; and

WHEREAS, due primarily to the ongoing use of gasoline-powered vehicles, the transportation sector is the largest contributor of greenhouse-gas emissions in California, making up 40% of those emissions; and

WHEREAS, Angelenos – particularly those who face socioeconomic and health inequities – are daily affected by the health and safety risks of air pollution resulting from the widespread use of gasoline-powered vehicles within Los Angeles; and

WHEREAS, widespread adoption of zero-emission vehicles will reduce air and climate pollution, resulting in healthier air for all Angelenos and saving lives; and


WHEREAS, the number of zero-emission vehicles in the California has increased by more than 3,000% over the last eight years, growing from 25,000 in 2012 to 763,816 in 2020, with sales continuing to expand every year; and

WHEREAS, zero-emission vehicles are expected to soon achieve price parity with gasoline-powered vehicles, removing financial barriers to their widespread adoption; and





RESOLUTION

PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC), Section 41.18(c)(1) states that sitting, lying, sleeping, or storing, using, maintaining, or placing personal property, in or upon any street, sidewalk, or other public right-of-way within the distance stated on the posted signage (up to a maximum of 500 feet) of a property designated as a sensitive use. For a property to be designated as a "sensitive use," the property must be a School, Day Care Center, Public Park, or Public Library, as those terms are defined in Section 105.01 of this Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code, section 105.01, "School" means an institution of learning for minors, whether public or private, which offers instruction in grades K through 12 in those courses of study required by the California Education Code or which is maintained pursuant to standards set by the State Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Municipal Code, section 41.18(d), states: No person shall be found to be in violation of any prohibition set forth in Subsection (c), unless and until: (i) the City Council has taken action, by resolution, to designate a specified area or areas for enforcement against sitting, lying, sleeping, or storing, using, maintaining, or placing personal property, or otherwise obstructing the public right-of-way; (ii) the City has posted signage at the designated area or areas set forth in the resolution, with such signage including reference to any required findings adopted in the resolution, and giving notice of the date after which no sitting, lying, sleeping, or storing, using, maintaining, or placing personal property, or otherwise obstructing the public right-of-way will be allowed; and (iii) at least 14 calendar days have passed from the date on which the signage is posted at the designated area or areas.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 41.18(c)(1) and 41.18(d) hereby prohibits sitting, lying, sleeping, or storing, using, maintaining, or placing personal property, in or upon any street, sidewalk, or other public rights-of-way within a radius of 500 feet from the schools listed in Attachment A, attached hereto and contained within the Council File.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of this Resolution, the Department of Transportation be directed to post signs giving notice of the restrictions in the radius specified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Legislative Analyst be authorized to make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.






