INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the fourth proposed contract amendment with Unisys Corporation for LATAX post-implementation application support services and software enhancements.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Director, Office of Finance, and the General Manager, Information Technology Agency (ITA), to execute the Fourth Amendment to the Supplemental Agreement to Contract No. C-101701 between the City and Unisys Corporation, in the amount of \$1,702,041 and extending the term of the contract to June 30, 2007, for continued post-implementation support and software enhancement of the LATAX System, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and compliance with the insurance requirements as determined by the City's Risk Manager.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The City Administrative Officer reports that funding for the initial \$550,137 of the \$1,702,041 required for this amendment is provided from available funds in the ITA 2005-06 budget as indicated in the Mid-Year Adjustment and Financial Status Report dated March 13, 2006, approved by the Council on March 31, 2006, and concurred by the Mayor on April 4, 2006. The remaining \$1,151,904 is included in the 2006-07 Mayor's Proposed Budget for ITA. The execution of this amendment does not obligate the

City to utilize all contractor services or to use all the allocated funds. The ITA will use the services on an as-needed and within available funding. This recommendation complies with the City's financial policies in that ongoing revenue will be used to finance the cost of the contract amendment.
