Recommendation for Council action:

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Police Department to:

- a. Establish an Illegal Fireworks Response Plan for the Fourth of July for each of the City's 19 police divisions, partnering with all applicable City and public agencies who play a role in enforcement, using overtime funding if necessary, to ensure sufficient staffing.
- b. Instruct the divisions' Senior Lead Officers to work with local neighborhood councils, residents' associations, and other community leaders to get the word out about the City's efforts and enlist the public in efforts to crack down on the use of illegal fireworks.
