RESOLUTION relative to the Declaration of Local Emergency by the Mayor, dated May 17, 2007, due to the occurrence of a wild land fire in the Griffith Park area which has caused significant damage to public property in and around the Griffith Park area, pursuant to the provisions of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) Section 8.27.

Recommendation for Council action:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION of the Mayor's Declaration of Local Emergency, directing all appropriate City departments, agencies and personnel to perform all duties and responsibilities to represent the City of Los Angeles in this matter for the purpose of abating the emergency and receipt, processing and coordination of all inquiries and requirements necessary to obtain whatever State and Federal assistance that may become available to the citizens of the City of Los Angeles who may be affected by the emergency; authorizing the City Administrative Officer to execute for and on behalf of the City all applications for State or Federal assistance which may be made available; instructing the Emergency Operations Board to advise the Mayor and Council on this Declaration of Local Emergency as may be required; and further, INSTRUCT the City Clerk to forward copies of this Resolution to the Governor of the State of California, the Director of the Office of Emergency Services of the State of California, and the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors.

(Pursuant to Section 8.27 of the LAAC, Council approval of the existence of a local emergency and need for continuing state of local emergency is required within seven days from the original declaration by the Mayor and every 14 days thereafter until terminated.)

Councilmember LaBonge moved, seconded by Councilmember Parks, that the Special Council meeting adjourn.
