EXEMPTION AND CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION, PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION imposing interim regulations on the issuance of building and demolition permits in a portion of the Northeast Los Angeles Community Plan area within the proposed Garvanza Historic Preservation Overlay Zone (HPOZ).

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. FIND that this action is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Article II, Section 2(m) and Article 19, Section 15308 of the City's Guidelines.
2. ADOPT the October 5, 2007 FINDINGS of the Director of Planning as the Findings of the Council.
3. PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE, approved by the Director of Planning, imposing interim regulations on the issuance of building and demolition permits in a portion of the Northeast Los Angeles Community Plan area within the proposed Garvanza HPOZ generally bounded by the Pasadena city limits on the north, the Metro Gold Line right-of-way bridge on the south, the east side of Avenue 66 on the east, and the east side of Figueroa proceeding to the west side of Avenue 63 at York Boulevard on the west.
