COMMUNICATION FROM THE CITY ATTORNEY and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION amending the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) to modify the City's police hiring bonus program.

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE amending the LAAC to modify the City's police hiring bonus program to end the bonus for recruits after the April 2008 class, and to provide the bonus to lateral transfers subject to the availability of budgeted funds.
