CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION (HAHN for GREUEL - REYES) relative to the City's position on AB 212 (Fuentes), which would amend Section 65860.5 of the Government Code.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2007-08 State Legislative Program OPPOSITION to AB 212 (Fuentes), which would require the City to consider the application for certain zone changes on the General Plan designation in place at the time the zone change application is filed, inasmuch as the City already has a "Vesting Zone Change" provision in place, Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 12.32 Q, which allows zone change applicants to file for a vesting zone change provided their applications provide sufficient detail of the proposed development.
