PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to prohibiting ownership, possession, purchase, or receipt of a firearm for ten years from the date of certain additional misdemeanor convictions which carry gang enhancement penalties.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Resolution (Weiss - Hahn - Garcetti), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

1. ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2009-10 State Legislative Program SPONSORSHIP of legislation to prohibit ownership, possession, purchase, or receipt of a firearm for ten years from the date of a misdemeanor conviction for the following crimes: carrying a concealed weapon; possession of an assault weapon; burglary; and any misdemeanor where, in conjunction with that misdemeanor, the conviction carried a gang enhancement penalty under Penal Code Section 186.22 *et. seq.*

2. REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance to amend the Los Angeles Municipal Code to reflect the proposed prohibition of ownership, possession, purchase, or receipt of a firearm as described above.
