COMMUNICATION FROM THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS (Board) relative to the National Basketball Association (NBA) Entertainment contract with the City of Los Angeles for events related to the NBA All-Star Game and related events.

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Bureau of Street Services, Investigation and Enforcement Division, to issue an event permit to the NBA Entertainment for all events related to NBA All-Star Week in Los Angeles 2011.
