COMMUNICATION FROM THE CITY ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER (CAO) relative to a proposed Second Amendment to a contract with Diamond Contract Services, Inc. (Contractor) to provide building custodial and cleaning services.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the General Manager, Department of General Services (GSD), to execute a contract amendment with Diamond Contract Services, Inc. to provide building custodial and cleaning services from April 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012. Compensation to the Contractor for these services is not-to-exceed \$4,075,000 and total contract amount not-to-exceed \$12,075,000, subject to review by the City Attorney as to form.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that funding in the amount of \$4,075,000 for this contract is available in the Contractual Services Account of the GSD for the current fiscal year. There is no additional impact on the General Fund. The above recommendation complies with the City Financial Policies in that ongoing revenue will be used to fund the contract.
