COMMUNICATION FROM THE CITY ATTORNEY and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to the amendment of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) to provide a health benefit subsidy for Tier 6 members of the Los Angeles Fire and Police Pension Plan retiring on service-connected disability pensions, and related matters.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT the accompanying ORDINANCE, which amends Chapters 11.5 and 22 of Division 4 of the LAAC to provide a health subsidy at age 55 for Tier 6 Plan Members who retire on service-connected disability pensions with less than 10 years of service and to provide a health insurance premium subsidy to Tier 6 Plan Members on the same terms and conditions that apply to retired members of other Tiers consistent with Charter Sections 1700, et. seq. established pursuant to Charter Amendment G adopted by the electorate at the City of Los Angeles Primary and Consolidated Elections on March 8, 2011, and other technical amendments.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.
