COMMUNICATION FROM THE CITY ATTORNEY relative to accepting grant awards for the Dispute Resolution Program.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- APPROVE the proposed agreement between the City and the County of Los Angeles Department of Community and Senior Services for the Dispute Resolution Program in the amount of \$136,490 (Community Services) and \$137,810 (Victim-Offender) for the period of July 1, 2014 -June 30, 2015, subject to City Attorney approval as to form and legality.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to accept the grant in the amount of \$136,490 (Community Services) and \$137,810 (Victim-Offender) from the County of Los Angeles.
- 3. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to execute amendments for the fiscal years (2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018, 2018-2019) for the same services in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 per grant per fiscal year.
- 4. APPROVE the City match for the period of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.
- 5. AUTHORIZE the City Controller to:
 - a. Establish a receivable within Fund 368 in the amount of \$274,300 from the County of Los Angeles.
 - b. Establish two new appropriation accounts within Fund 368 as follows:

FY 14-15 DRP Grant (Community Services)\$136,490FY 14-15 DRP Grant (Victim-Offender)\$137,810

6. TRANSFER \$190,820 from Fund 368 to Fund 100/12, Account 1020-Salaries Grant reimbursed.

7. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to prepare Controller instructions for any necessary technical adjustments, subject to approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO); and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement these instructions.
