06-0002-S15 (Smith - Zine) with the concurrence of the Mayor, that the City include in its 2005-06 State Legislative Program, support of AB 1841 (Bogh) which would amend the Welfare and Institutions Code to require a petition to commit an individual to the State Department of Mental Health for treatment if one of the evaluating independent professionals of sexual offenders makes the determination that there is a need for further treatment of an individual.

06-0002-S14 (Reyes - Garcetti - Huizar) with the concurrence of the Mayor, that the City includes in its 2005-06 Federal Legislative Program, support for the extension of the Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for Salvadorean, Honduran and Nicaraguans and urges President George W. Bush to announce the extension of said program in the time stipulated by law in order to avoid more suffering and hardship amongst TPS holders and their families.

(Wesson - Cárdenas) instructing the Planning Department, with the assistance of the City Attorney, to prepare and present an Interim Control Ordinance, to prohibit the issuance of demolition, building, and any other applicable permits, within the geographical area bounded by 6th Street to the north, Olympic Boulevard to the south, Wilton Place to the east, and Crenshaw Boulevard to the west; etc.

(Weiss - Zine) subject to the approval of the Mayor, authorize the Mayor's Office of Homeland Security and Public Safety to submit the Urban Area Security Initiative grant application to the State Office of Homeland Security on behalf of the City of Los Angeles and the Los Angeles-Long Beach Urban Area; etc.

06-0002-S16 (Greuel - Garcetti for Rosendahl - Weiss - Smith - Reyes) with the concurrence of the Mayor, that the City include in its 2005-06 State Legislative Program, support of a comprehensive transportation financing agreement, including a bond measure in 2006 to significantly increase funding for transportation and mass transit, as may be proposed by the Governor's "Strategic Growth Plan," (SB 1024 (Perata) and/or AB 1783 (Nunez), provided the agreement also includes the provisions as outlined in detail in said Resolution; etc.
