(Wesson - Garcetti) authorizing the Los Angeles Housing Department to reimburse the County of Los Angeles for the City's 50% share of the accounting and audit services provided the Blue Consulting group, not to exceed \$220,000, to continue managing the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority's (LAHSA) financials until the retention and transition of LAHSA's new Chief Financial Officer is complete; etc.
