(Garcetti - Rosendahl) that the Council instruct the Bureau of Engineering to modify the improvement requirements for the development located at 6290 West Sunset Boulevard. (APCC-2005-7302-ZC-SPE-SPP); defer the widening of the pavement on the south side of Sunset Boulevard by five feet adjacent to the subject property; and limit the street improvements along Santa Monica Boulevard to the removal and reconstruction of any broken, off-grade or bad order concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk, thereby retaining a sidewalk width of a minimum of 15 feet in that section.
