(Smith - Reyes) that the Council instruct the Planning Department, with the assistance of the Transportation Department (LADOT), and in consultation with the City Attorney, to prepare a report within 45 days that provides recommendations to revise the ratio of compact parking spaces to "standard size" parking spaces in new commercial buildings to reflect the reality of current vehicle size, and recommend any needed changes to the Los Angeles Municipal Code.
