ROSENDAHL HIRES ENVIRONMENTAL DEPUTY

Deborah Weinstein Will Push Councilman's Environmental Vision for the District

LOS ANGELES - Committed to fulfilling his pledge to be a champion of the environment, Councilman Bill Rosendahl has hired a new environmental deputy to serve the 11th district.

Deborah Weinstein, an environmental policy expert who served as an official with the U.S. Department of the Interior, joined Rosendahl's staff May 15.

"I am extremely happy that Deborah has joined my team," Rosendahl said. "Deborah has a unique perspective on environmental policy. Her experience working at the federal level combined with her passion for serving the community will be invaluable to the district."

A Southern California native, Weinstein relocated from Washington D.C. to join the Rosendahl team.

"I am excited to help Councilman Rosendahl implement his vision of a Los Angeles with cleaner water, cleaner air, and more open space," Weinstein said. "I am impressed by his commitment, and by the dedication of his staff."

Weinstein earned her Bachelor of Arts from the University of California, Santa Barbara and a Masters degree in Public Policy from the University of California, Los Angeles.

She spent the past five years working on natural resource and environmental policy issues for the U.S. Department of the Interior, in Washington, D.C. Prior to that, she worked as an intern for the White House Council on Environmental Quality during the Clinton Administration, and later worked as a legislative associate on transportation and environmental issues for a D.C. government

relations firm.

As a member of the Rosendahl staff, Weinstein will staff the councilman on the Santa Monica Bay Restoration Commission, steer the councilman's environmental initiatives, work on environmentally sensitive planning and development issues, and work closely with organizations such as Heal the Bay and Santa Monica Baykeeper.
