TO HONOR NANCY DALY RIORDAN AT PanCAN GALA**

What: Los Angeles City Councilmember Bill Rosendahl will join local leaders to honor Nancy Daly Riordan at the 9th Annual *An Evening With The Stars...Goes Hollywood*.

The gala, which promises to be a star-studded event, benefits the Pancreatic Cancer Action Network and will honor Mrs. Riordan with the Emily Couric Public Service Award.

Rosendahl introduced a motion this week requesting the Santa Monica Mountain Conservancy to name the new trail in the Santa Monica Mountains, the "Nancy and Dick Riordan Trail". The trail, located near the Mountaingate development in Brentwood, connects the Mount Saint Mary Fire Road to the Canyonback Trail and was the result of a dispute resolution between area developers, homeowners and

trail users. Nancy and Dick Riordan played a large role in bringing all parties together for the agreement.

Rosendahl also plans to introduce a resolution next week requesting the City of Los Angeles to designate November, "Pancreatic Cancer Awareness" month.

The Pancreatic Cancer Network, Inc. (PanCAN), a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization, is the first national patient-based advocacy organization to focus on pancreatic cancer. PanCAN advocates for increased research dollars for pancreatic cancer from the federal government, and educates the public, legislators, health and research communities about pancreatic cancer, the risks of the disease and the latest advancements in treatment, detection and prevention.
