Dear Friends,

Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) will host the next LAX Air Quality & Source Apportionment Study Briefing at 1 p.m., Wednesday, September 10. This will be an opportunity for you to provide feedback on the progress of the “Air Quality & Source Apportionment Pilot Study,” presently underway at LAX.

I have heard concerns from many of you that LAX area communities, including Westchester, and most particularly including neighborhoods in Playa Del Rey, will be understudied, or that monitoring stations there will not be adequate. Let me be clear: **I will not support an Air Quality Study that does not place monitoring stations in both Westchester and Playa del Rey.** I want to understand with absolute clarity the impact our airport has on these neighborhoods, and I know that you do too. At this meeting, you will hear from the Air Quality & Source Apportionment Study Working Group regarding this and other issues that may concern you.

This study is a requirement of the landmark LAX Legal Settlement Agreement that Mayor Villaraigosa and I brokered with the airport, community representatives of Westchester and Playa del Rey, and other jurisdictions surrounding LAX. I consider it a critical part of our strategy to address airport impacts on those who live and work in our area.
