**What:** Councilmember Bill Rosendahl will host a community meeting with Loyola Marymount University (LMU) faculty, students, city officials and residents who live near the Westchester campus as part of an ongoing effort to address community complaints about off-campus student behavior.

In an attempt to crack down on what many Westchester homeowners believed were out-of-control parties in their neighborhoods, Rosendahl formed a task force with residents, LMU, the City's Attorney's office and the Pacific division of the LAPD last August. The initial goal to reduce the number of complaints about off-campus parties is being met with increased public safety enforcement and community involvement. The LMU Task Force will continue developing solutions to improve the relationship between the university and nearby residents from year to year.

Attendees will be given all the necessary contacts and information needed to work together as neighbors to resolve any future problems that might arise from student off-campus activities.
