What: In recognition of Airport Police Officer Tommy Scott's heroic service to the City of Los Angeles, Councilman Bill Rosendahl will join local officials and friends and family members of the fallen officer to name a portion of Lincoln Boulevard in his memory.

Four years ago, Officer Scott was killed in a confrontation with a man near Los Angeles International Airport. Scott is the only airport police officer to lose his life in the line of duty since the organization began in 1946. He was 35 years old and a four year veteran of the Airport Police at the time of his death.

The exact location where Scott was killed is marked with a permanent memorial and plaque bearing his name and is centered between the two newly placed signs.
