Fire Season is Around the Corner, So Make Plans for Brush Clearance

Starting May 1, properties in the Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone (VHFHSZ) will be inspected by the Fire Department to check for mandatory brush clearance to help protect neighborhoods from wildfires.

Homeowners living in this zone, which includes the northern and western edge of the San Fernando Valley, will receive reminders by mail from the Fire Department.

Brush fires occur every year during hot, dry conditions, especially in summer when vegetation that grows during winter and spring becomes dry and flammable. Homeowners' participation in brush clearance helps keep the community safe from wildfires!
