COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS FOR HUIZAR, CARDENAS

Council President Eric Garcetti announced additional committee assignments for Councilmember Tony Cardenas and Councilmember Jose Huizar.

Effective immediately, Cardenas will join the Energy and Environment Committee and fill the vacancy left by the departure of Councilmember Alex Padilla. Huizar will join the Ad Hoc Committee on Gang Violence and Youth Development to fill the vacancy left by the resignation earlier this week of Councilmember Bill Rosendahl from that committee.

“I’m pleased to announce these committee assignments,” said Garcetti. “Councilmember Cardenas has pursued continuous improvement in DWP’s performance, and Councilmember Huizar’s dedication to this city’s youth is unparalleled.”

“We set an aggressive goal with the city's Renewable Energy Portfolio Standard,” said Councilmember Cardenas, “and I look forward to working with Chairwoman Jan Perry to do more.”

“Public safety is my top priority, and I look forward to working with Chairman Cardenas and the other committee members in taking on this critical work,” said Councilmember Huizar. “Given the recent events in my district, one thing is clear: we cannot arrest our way out of the gang crisis. As such, I will be focused on creating genuine opportunities and alternatives to gang life for the children and youth of this great city.”
