COMMISSION FOR CHILDREN YOUTH AND THEIR FAMILIES / CENTRAL CLEARINGHOUSE / CREATION

**Subject**

Motion - Close collaboration and partnership between the City of Los Angeles and the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) are critical, both to maximizing public resources, and to effectively serving the children, youth, and families in the City.

One of the responsibilities of the Commission for Children, Youth and Their Families (CCYF), outlined in the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC), is to promote coordination between the City, LAUSD, and other educational and governmental entities, parents' groups, and community-based organizations concerned with children, youth and their families.

Programmatic collaboration and joint-use activities, however, are currently handled on an ad hoc basis by a host of City Departments. A streamlined process should be developed to assist City departments and community stakeholders in forging effective collaborations between the City and the Los Angeles Unified School District. This process could be supported by the creation of a centralized clearinghouse, housed at the Commission, to track and expand such collaborative efforts.

THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council instruct the City Administrative Officer, with the assistance of the Commission for Children, Youth and Their Families, the City Attorney, the Department of Recreation and Parks, and other affected departments, to report back on the feasibility of establishing CCYF as the central clearinghouse for programmatic joint use and collaboration between the City of Los Angeles and the Los Angeles Unified School District.

FURTHER MOVE that the report should include specific recommendations for how the Clearinghouse could both keep track of collaborative efforts between the City and the School District, and provide enhanced assistance to Departments and stakeholders to further expand these efforts across the City.

FURTHER MOVE that the report should address any changes required to the LAAC to implement these proposals.
