MOTION

The Coca-Cola Corporation is a long-standing member of the downtown business community and has made significant investments in order to retain operations in the City of Los Angeles and continue to provide quality jobs.

The vacation of the portion of 14th Street between Naomi and Central would allow for a safer, more productive transfer of goods from one portion of the operation to another and would allow for safer, more consistent upkeep of the area.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Planning Department be directed to amend the Central City Community Plan and the Transportation Element of the City's General Plan by re-designating a segment of 14th Street from Central Avenue to Naomi Avenue from its current street classification of Secondary Highway to a Collector Street.


I FURTHER MOVE that, upon the effective date of the above identified re-designation, street vacation proceedings to vacate this segment of 14th Street be initiated pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code, Division 9, Part 3, Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be directed to investigate the feasibility of this vacation request.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be directed to present its report regarding the feasibility of vacating the requested area to the Public Works Committee.

I FURTHER MOVE that upon review by the Public Works Committee, the City Clerk be directed to schedule this street vacation request for the City Council's consideration at the appropriate time under the City's street vacation procedures.
