## EDUCATION & NEIGHBORHOODS


Throughout the City, there are residents, community groups and neighborhood councils who are interested in staying informed of construction and development plans in their neighborhoods.

Currently, neighborhood councils are sent notifications of applications which have been filed with the planning department for that neighborhood council's geographic area. There have been reports of area planning notifications being sent to the incorrect neighborhood councils, inhibiting the ability of interested residents to be aware of projects being considered in their area.


It is imperative that interested residents of the City of Los Angeles have the access to the information they need to be fully informed as to any potential changes to neighborhood land use patterns.

**I THEREFORE MOVE** that the Council instruct Planning Department and the Office of the City Clerk with the assistance of the City Attorney, to prepare a report within 30 days that delineates the degree to which notification is provided to neighborhood residents and neighborhood councils when there is a land use project development, and their coordination if any, with the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment (DONE).
