LOS ANGELES – Councilmember José Huizar will host the Second Annual Operation Gobble-Gobble (Thanksgiving dinner giveaway) in Boyle Heights, along with the generous support from Food 4 Less, the Roybal Youth and Family Center and the Community Redevelopment Agency.
