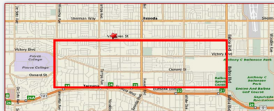

- Researching post-WWII subdivisions and tracts
- Locating intact tracts and subdivisions that may form historic districts
- Researching important architects, builders and developers and where they worked
- Identifying neighborhood places associated with important people, and events
- Taking photographs of buildings and places
