Primary Nominating and Consolidated Election March 3rd, 2009

VOTER REGISTRATION

The last day to register to vote for the March 3, 2009 City Election is Tuesday, February 17, 2009. Voter registration forms are available throughout Los Angeles such as government offices, fire stations, libraries, State Motor Vehicle offices, Public Assistance offices (DPSS and WIC) and Post Offices.

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder provides voter registration forms and assistance in English and the six federally-mandated languages (*Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog and Vietnamese*). VOTE-BY-MAIL

If you are unable to go to the polls on Election Day, you can still vote by casting a Vote-By-Mail ballot. You may request a Vote-By-Mail ballot by completing and submitting a Vote-By-Mail Application. The Vote-By-Mail Ballot Application is on the back cover of your Official Sample Ballot or you can print one from this web site <http://cityclerk.lacity.org/election/engvbm.pdf>. The City Clerk must receive all Vote-By-Mail Applications by Tuesday, February 24, 2009, 5:00 p.m. Mail the application to the address shown on the application or you may fax it to (213) 485-7806.
