

City of Los Angeles 18th Annual Emergency Preparedness Fair Poster Contest



❖ Open to students in grades 6 – 12 or organizations which serve children from 10-18 yrs of age. Entries can be individual or per organization.

Poster Guidelines:

❖ Poster will be judged based on originality in interpreting the theme, visual impact of design and quality of the work. Only two-dimensional original submissions will be accepted in the following format: watercolor, acrylic, oil, pen, pencil, or chalk on paper.

❖ Submission not to exceed 11"X 14" (without a mat board). Any entry over 11" x 14" will NOT be eligible.

Deadline: Thursday, May 21st, 2009 at 3:00 p.m. (This is NOT a postmark date.)

Prizes: Three winners will be selected for Grand Prizes. Runner-up prizes will also be awarded.

- Winning individuals, schools or facilities will receive recognition on Friday, September 11, 2009 at the City of Los Angeles City Council meeting and reception.
- The winning art may be used on the 2009 marketing material along with the school / facility name displayed on flyers, banners and posters through out the City.
- Winning individuals, schools or facilities will receive a generous selection of emergency preparedness books and / or novels suitable for this age group.
- The art may be displayed at selected locations through out the City during the month of September.
