The City of Los Angeles is developing an Energy Efficiency and Conservation Strategy (EECS) to determine how best to utilize the \$37 million of federal stimulus money provided to the City from the Department of Energy (DOE) as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). The City is looking for public input into how best to use these funds and recommendations on the scope and priorities of the strategy.

There will be a total of seven meetings held throughout the City. These will be Open Houses designed to allow members of the public to come and go as they please. At these meetings you will learn about eligible energy efficiency and conservation activities as well as have the opportunity to provide your comments and opinions on how you think your city should spend the grant funding.
