The Office of the City Clerk – Election Division invites you, your family, and your friends to take part in the electoral process by signing up to be a pollworker for the upcoming 2009 Council District 2 Special Election.

We are especially looking for individuals who speak English and one of the six federally-mandated languages (Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog, Vietnamese) or who would like to be an Inspector. Inspectors are in charge of the polling place on Election Day.

On Election Day, pollworkers work from approximately 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Inspectors receive a \$100 stipend. Clerks receive a \$80 stipend. In addition, you will be paid an additional \$25 for attending a mandatory training class, as long as you work on Election Day. Training classes will be scheduled across the City and in your community.

You can make a difference in your community and the lives of your friends and neighbors. Help them participate. Help people vote.

To be a pollworker, you must be:

- At least 18 years old;
- A United States Citizen;
- A registered voter; and
- Able to speak, read and write English or bilingual
