Subject: Community Meeting – Mulholland Pipeline Project Phase 1

The Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) invites you to attend a community meeting at 6:30 p.m., Thursday, January 21, 2010, in the conference room of the Woodland Hills Branch Library, located at 22200 Ventura Boulevard, Woodland Hills, CA 91364. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the upcoming work associated with the construction of Phase 1 of the Mulholland Pipeline Project.

The Mulholland Pipeline Project, when completed, will improve water system reliability for current users and provide an additional source of water for fire protection and emergencies. This project will directly benefit residents in the City of Los Angeles along Mulholland Drive from approximately Topanga Canyon Boulevard to Santa Maria Road.

Phase 1 of the Mulholland Pipeline Project will install 2,020-feet of 16-inch diameter ductile iron water pipe in paved sections of Mulholland Drive between Picasso Avenue and Saltillo Street. The construction of Phase 1 is scheduled to begin in late February 2010 and complete by the end of May 2010. Construction will be performed by personnel from the Water Distribution Business Unit, West Valley District and will occur Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. with the possibility of occasional work on Saturdays.

The typical construction zone will move along the street with the excavation of the trench, installation of pipe, and backfill of the trench. Steel plates may temporarily cover the trench until final asphalt paving is placed. Traffic may be delayed or routed around the active construction zone. Parking will be affected within the active construction zone.

In order to provide adequate space for construction work and traffic, the Department of Transportation will post "Temporary Tow-Away, No Parking" signs on Mulholland Drive, within the work zone. Vehicles parked in the temporary no-parking zone will be ticketed and towed at the owner's expense.
