NON- TAX DEBTOR AMNESTY PROGRAM

Save 40% on select, seriously aged outstanding City bills!

Have you been contacted by a collection agency for monies owed to the City of Los Angeles? Here is your opportunity to settle select and qualified delinquent accounts (does not include taxes) at a reduced rate.

- Simply pay the Amnesty Balance owing on your collection letter, which is 60% of your bill and 40% will be waived (not to exceed \$50,000).
- Act fast, the program runs from February 1, 2011 through April 30, 2011. Payment must be received or postmarked on or before the April 30 deadline.
- Qualifying delinquent debts include, but are not limited to, false alarm fees, ambulance billing fees, brush clearance fees, code enforcement fees, building and safety fines, public works permits, fines for illegal signs and certain other service fees that have been referred for collection to the City's contracted collection agencies.
