**Vanowen Street Bridge over Los Angeles River Project**  
**Construction Activities through April 2012.**

<b>What work will be done?</b>	Reconstruction of the Vanowen Street Bridge over the L.A. River Channel. The project will be constructed in two stages. Half of the bridge will always remain open to through traffic. Stage one will be the reconstruction of the west bound portion and stage two will be the reconstruction of the east bound section.
<b>Where is the work occurring?</b>	Vanowen Street Bridge over the L.A. River (near the corner of Vanowen Street and Mason Street)
<b>When will work begin and end?</b>	Work is anticipated to start in March 2011 and complete in April 2012.
<b>What time will crews be working?</b>	7 a.m. to 4 p.m. from Monday to Friday, excluding holidays.
<b>What can I expect?</b>	Minor delays going through the construction area due to Vanowen Street Bridge being reduced to a single lane each direction.
<b>Will local access be impacted?</b>	Yes, expect minor delays going through the bridge.
<b>Safety Measures</b>	Traveling public will be redirected to one side of the bridge (east bound for stage one and west bound for stage two). There will be K-Rails, signs and barricades to help direct and protect motorists.
