



OUR HOUSE is a non-profit organization providing grief support services, education, resources, and hope to children and adults who have experienced the death of someone close. For over 16 years, OUR HOUSE has been the primary resource for grief related needs within Los Angeles County and has helped thousands of grieving children, teens, and adults as they embark upon their journeys to hope and healing.

OUR HOUSE, founded in 1993, believes that griever deserve the opportunity to begin the healing process in a safe, warm, and nurturing environment. We also believe that the healing process is enhanced through the relationships that are developed in support groups.

OUR HOUSE serves over 4,000 people each year through the following programs:

Camp Erin: A weekend-long camp experience for grieving children ages 6-17. This camp incorporates traditional, fun, high-energy camp activities with grief education and emotional support.

School-Based Grief Support Groups: Serving inner city, at-risk youth who have experienced the death of someone close. Many of the deaths are related to drugs, alcohol, violence, or gang related activity.

In-house Support Groups: For children (as young as four years old), teens, and adults who have experienced the death of a parent, sibling, spouse, or other close friend or relative. Centers are located in West Los Angeles and Woodland Hills.

El Centro de la Esperanza: Serving Spanish-speaking adults within an emphasis on culturally sensitive grief support. Groups are provided at satellite locations throughout Los Angeles.

Education Programs: Providing education to first-year medical students at UCLA & USC, rabbinical students/clergy, and mental health professionals.

On-Site Grief Response: Offering grief support to schools, organizations, and businesses after the death of a classmate, client, or co-worker.
