PATRICE RUSHEN, NDUGU CHANCLER, and DOC POWELL

Patrice Rushen is a session musician, producer, arranger, film composer, and is the only woman to have served as the Musical Director for the Annual Grammy Awards. She earned her own Grammy Award nominations for Best R&B vocal performance for "Forget-Me-Nots" and best R&B instrumental for "Number One." **Ndugu Chancler** is a world-class drummer, percussionist, and composer. He recorded hits with Frank Sinatra, Herbie Hancock, Weather Report, John Lee Hooker, and Kenny Rogers. Grammy nominated guitarist **Doc Powell** has contributed to over 140 recordings with some of the premier stars in Pop, R&B, Jazz and Gospel music.

During the '60s, **Canned Heat** was known for their hit "Going Up The Country," the unofficial theme song for the famed documentary, *Woodstock*.

Country Joe McDonald's album, *Country Joe and the Fish* was released in 1965, just before the anti-war Vietnam Day Teach-In in Berkeley, CA. He sang "I-Feel-Like-I'm-Fixin'-to-Die-Rag" to a half-million people at the Woodstock Arts and Music Festival in 1969. Opening for "Hillstock" is **Tom Wallbank and the Abassadors**, known for his style on harmonic, slide guitar and vocals. Also appearing is blues guitarist and vocalist **Dennis Jones** and the L.A. based **Shoemaker Brothers**.
