

Officer Scott had served with the Los Angeles International Airport Police Department for 4 years and was only 35 years old when he made the ultimate sacrifice in service to the people of the City of Los Angeles.


In recognition of Officer Scott's heroic service to Los Angeles, it is appropriate that the City honor his memory by naming a portion of Lincoln Boulevard near Los Angeles International Airport as "Officer Tommy Scott Square."


