

# MOTION

Councilman Dennis P. Zine is sponsoring the "Neighborhood Block Party" on July 7, 2007, from 1:00 P.M. to 11:00 P.M. The event will be a neighborhood block party so that neighbors may get acquainted with one another. Approximately 100 participants are expected.

Council District Three has received a request that the City provide certain services and declare this function a Special Event. Approval of this request will mean that an estimated \$3,569 in fees and salary costs will be absorbed by the City. (Event Coordinator: Priscilla Desmuke - 818/342-2996 and Fax No. 818/342-2996.)

I THEREFORE MOVE that the "Neighborhood Block Party" be declared a Special Event, and City departments be requested to waive all fees and costs, including insurance. The event sponsor shall meet the application requirements of the City.

I FURTHER MOVE that pursuant to Ordinance No. 150,567 relating to temporary street closures, the following streets be closed on July 7, 2007, from 12:00 Noon to 12:00 Midnight, subject to the supervision of the Director of the Bureau of Street Services:

- 6400 Block of Bertrand between Victory and Tellez in Reseda.


I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Street Services be directed to furnish the necessary traffic control devices. These devices will be provided with the understanding that the sponsoring organization will pick up and return them to the Bureau, and remove any debris following this event.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Transportation be directed to post "Temporary No Stopping" signs and provide traffic control personnel, if necessary.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Council authorize the Chief Legislative Analyst, or his designee, to make technical corrections or clarifications as may be necessary to implement the intent of this Motion.

I FURTHER MOVE that should unforeseen circumstances change the actual date of the Special Event, the aforementioned departmental instructions shall continue to apply.
