The late Bob McCord settled in the West San Fernando Valley in 1976 to establish the Sagebrush Cantina Restaurant in Calabasas. The Sagebrush Cantina became a local landmark and community gathering spot, serving up an award-winning Mexican/Californian menu as well as a variety of entertainment. The restaurant also served as Mr. McCord's showcase of antique circus artifacts that included calliopes and carousels.

With his flamboyant personality, Mr. McCord was a community icon and developed a loyal customer base of residents, families, young adults, government officials, and celebrities. Among his various achievements, Mr. McCord served as president of the Calabasas Chamber of Commerce.


Mr. McCord was known for his community support and generosity, helping to raise funds for local schools, political candidates and special programs. For the past 20 years, he opened the Sagebrush Cantina each Thanksgiving to feed up to 500 senior citizens a free turkey dinner. He was also known to fill up his catering truck and drive to active fire lines to feed firefighters.

In light of Mr. McCord's contributions to the community, it is appropriate that a portion of El Canon Avenue be named in his honor.
