
MOTION

Proposition F (Prop F), the Fire Facilities Bond, was approved in November 2000 by Los Angeles voters to replace, renovate and construct fire/paramedic/helicopter facilities. As part of the program, Prop F also identified the need to install fueling stations at individual fire stations sites.

Currently, the fuel tanks at several of these fire stations are not in service due to issues potentially related to defectively manufactured parts and poor workmanship. The fire stations affected by this problem must use either neighboring stations or a City issued credit card to fuel the fire trucks. This presents operational and public safety concerns.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering (BOE), Department of General Services (GSD), Bureau of Contract Administration (BCA), and the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) be instructed to report directly to Council and provide a comprehensive briefing on the issue of Prop F fueling stations that are out of service.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Attorney be instructed to report to Council on potential measures the City could take relative to contractor/manufacturer liability issues.
