

MOTION

The Fire Instruction Recruitment Education School to Career Academy (FIRE) is a partnership between the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) and Valley College. The organization mentors high school students and provides intensive instruction in firefighting skills provided by experienced LAFD firefighters.

The Office of Council District Three (3) has received a request to donate one 1984 Seagrave fire engine to FIRE to be used in the training of prospective firefighter candidates. The City has recently declared one 1984 Seagrave fire engine a surplus item that will fulfill the request of FIRE.

Based upon the criteria established in Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 22.547, FIRE is eligible to receive this donation and there are no other unfilled requests waiting ahead of this organization for this type of equipment.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council:

1. Authorize the sale of one surplus 1984 Seagrave fire engine (equipment no. 60411) to the Fire Instruction Recruitment Education School to Career Academy (FIRE) for \$1.00, and that the City Council find this sale and transfer of surplus equipment fulfills a humanitarian purpose.
2. Request the City Attorney to expedite preparation of the appropriate documents to effectuate the sale and transfer of the above identified surplus equipment at below market value to FIRE.
3. Instruct the City Clerk to inform FIRE [Selwyn A. Lloyd, 7419 Reseda Boulevard, Los Angeles, California 91335, (818) 756-8673] that the surplus fire engine must be claimed within 60 days from the date of Council approval of the request, at which time it will revert to the City's surplus equipment pool for disposal by the Department of General Services.
